Design for new Offshore Service Centre in Ostend unveiled

BRUSSELS | Elia will soon start construction on a sustainable offshore service centre in Ostend. The design submitted by the OYO-TRACTEBEL joint venture has been selected. The service centre will be built at a unique location in the port of Ostend, in line with the grid operator's offshore ambitions. There will be offices, a warehouse with a workshop, meeting and reception rooms, a crisis room and an operations control room. Next to the building will be direct access to the existing quay and jetty, where the new building can be seen as a gateway to Elia's offshore activities.

In late May, Elia signed a 40-year concession agreement with the Port of Ostend for a site on the quay in the port. Elia will build the Offshore Service Centre on this site, since the location is ideal for maintenance work at sea. Pursuant to a European procedure and competition, Elia selected the project submitted by OYO-TRACTEBEL, a joint venture in which OYO will act as architect and TRACTEBEL as engineering firm.

"OYO-TRACTEBEL's design came out on top in the competition and fully meets our functional requirements. Its innovative and sustainable concept faithfully reflects our offshore activities and Elia's values. From a technical point of view, the building has been designed to comply with BREEAM Very Good certification requirements and will lead the way in terms of sustainability."

"The design comprises a robust monolith (which houses the warehouse) surmounted by an adaptive and high-performance office building on piles, serving as a beacon in the landscape. This approach is in line with Elia's desire for an optimal design that is both aesthetically pleasing and functional. Our holistic approach to sustainability is clearly reflected in the design, where we strive for harmony with the surrounding area, the environment and ecological values. For example, the maintenance walkways double as solar protection. We also maximised the roof surface to serve as an energy landscape by fitting it with photovoltaic panels."
