









The Quevaucamps-Harchies high-voltage line: Invitation to an information session

On 19 March, Elia, your high-voltage electricity transmission system operator, organised a public information meeting to inform you about the planned reconstruction of the overhead line between Quevaucamps substation and Harchies, along a new, improved route.

At the meeting, Elia and the municipality of Bernissart officially collected everyone's comments and suggestions for the environmental impact assessment (EIA) carried out by CSD Ingénieurs, the independent, approved engineering consultancy.

Elia and CSD are now organising an information session to present the conclusions of that study.

The session will be held on Thursday, 3 October from 6-8 p.m. at the Maison Rurale in Blaton (address: rue Emile Carlier 15, 7321 Blaton).

They will aim to provide you with the fullest possible information on the project and contents of the environmental impact study, as well as giving us an opportunity to answer your questions.

Elia's Quevaucamps-Harchies project entails rebuilding a section of the overhead power line between the Quevaucamps substation and Harchies along a new, improved route. Once the new line has been commissioned, the current one can be dismantled.
