

T&C SA AND T&C OPA - ERRATUM

1.Introduction

This document describes the modifications made to the English versions of the Terms and Conditions for the Scheduling Agent (T&C SA) and the Terms and Conditions for the Outage Planning Agent (T&C OPA) that were first provided for public consultation on the 6th of June 2023. These modifications are related to some minor errors and typos in these English versions.

2. Modifications to the English version of the T&C OPA

In the Title 1: Definitions

• Electrical zone definition has been added

In the Title 2: Conditions for Participation

• In the article II3.2, second bullet point: the words *inferior to* were replaced by *lower than*

In the Title 3: Test prior to Participation

• In the article II 4.4: the reference to Art. I.6.1 was replaced by Art. I.6

In the Title 7: Invoicing

• In the article II.13.1: the words *as foreseen in Art. II.10.4* were added at the end of the first sentence.

In the Annex 2

• In the first sentence, a typo was corrected for the word *participate*

3. Modifications to the English version of the T&C SA

In the Title 1: Definitions

- Access point(s) definition: the words with a goal to injecting or taking off power have been corrected to with a goal to inject or take off
- Electrical zone definition has been added
- FCR definition: the words Frequency restoration Reserves have been corrected to Frequency Containment Reserve
- The order of the *Scheduling Agent* definition has been corrected and is now after the *Scheduled Activation* definition.

In the Annex 1

- Annex 1: the reference in the three last columns of the table *Annex 1 List of Delivery Points* was corrected from *Art. II.12* to *Art. II.14.1* (the enclosed excel template was also corrected)
- Annex 1C: the reference to Art. 7.9 was corrected to Art. 3.10

In the Annex 10

- Annex 10A: compensation was replaced by remuneration in the formula
- In the example 2): In case the requested (and offered) may-not-run would last for 25 hours" was corrected to "In case the requested (and offered) may-not-run would last for 26 hours"
- Annex 10 B: the words *or a delivery Point* were removed from the first sentence of the example
- Annex 10 C: some typos were corrected in the example by replacing the words *latest* available Daily EGIX by the latest available Daily EGIX is and the words latest available EGSI by the latest available EGSI is.
