




Status Functioning Rules

- Elia organized a public consultation on the functioning rules (28 August – 25 September 2020)
- Elia submitted the functioning rules to CREG (13 November 2020)
- CREG notified Elia that the functioning rules would not be approved without amendments
- Elia and CREG started organizing meetings to assess the changes needed to be made
- This process is ongoing
- Elia is committed to use its best efforts to facilitate an approval within the legal timeline (15 May)
- Changes may be required to comply with the CREG's requests



 - Assumptions based on the current legal framework interpretation








Concept



Auction demo platform | Practicalities



- CRM candidates needs to first create a user account to access demo environments
- Prequalification and auction demo environment are independent
- No synchronization between auction and prequalification databases in the demo environment
- CMU portfolio of each CRM candidate is created at once via an Excel file and used as input to automatic compliancy checks performed by the tool. CMU portfolio can be created for CRM candidate (company)



Auction demo platform | CMU Portfolio excel file

- The CRM candidate sends the completed **CMUs profile definition form** (.xlsx) **and associated company name** (as configured in the prequalification tool) to demo.crm@elia.be

- **CMU Data sheet:**

Value	Description
CMU ID	CMU ID as it would be defined in the prequalification tool (Candidate can choose it only for the Auction Demo)
Capacity Category	As defined in article 2, 84° of the Electricity Act. As referred to in article 7undecies § 7 of the Electricity Act, the Capacity Contract Durations 1-year, 3-years, 8-years and 15-years, depending on the category. Possible values: 1, 3, 8, 15
Process	Possible values: Standard, Specific
Process Status	Possible values: Additional, Existing, Virtual
Eligible Volume	The Reference Power of an Existing CMU or Additional CMU multiplied by the Derating Factor as determined during the Prequalification. [MW]
Remaining Eligible Volume	The maximum capacity that the Capacity Provider can contract for a Transaction on the Primary Market (as demonstrated in annex 17.1.18). This is the same value as EligibleVolume if the CMU is participating to an auction for the very first time. [MW]


Value	Description
CMU ID	CMUID as defined in the sheet "CMUData"
EAN	EAN code of the Delivery Point associated to the CMU defined in the column CMUID. Fictive value
Name	Delivery Point name associated to the CMU defined in the column CMUID
Linked Capacities	This list allows the CRM Candidate to enter the CRM ID of the Delivery Points that are located on the same geographical site and with a technical dependency. Only to be filled in if the Delivery Point, for which the information is being completed, is dependent on the Delivery Point in the table.
