# 2. Minutes of Meetings

<u>Disclaimer</u>: The slides used as a support of the presentation are available <u>online</u>. The minutes of meetings only cover the discussions that took place during the Working Group.

#### Approval of the Minutes

No further comments – the Minutes of the WG Adequacy #22 & #23 are approved.

#### Presentation auction results

Febeliec asks for further clarifications regarding the demand curve parameters. Elia explains that volumes were determined during the calibration process. Febeliec shares its concerns regarding the volumes of Demand Side Response (DSR). Elia welcomes the collaboration with the market parties to improve the scenarios.

## Presentation calibration reports

Febeliec asks under what circumstances does Elia deviate from ERAA. Elia answers that the Minister of Energy decided to add additional information on top of the ERAA 2022 data. Elia further mentions the different additional sources of information to enrich the ERAA 2022 data – as approved by the Minister. Several sensitivities based on the additional information was shared beforehand by Elia.

Concerning the volume parameters of the flexibility, FEBEG asks for clarification regarding how DSR from additional electrification in industry is accounted. Elia explains that assumptions are taken to move forward as the auction results will allow to fine-tune the methodology.

Engie points out that a part of the values used for the revenue computation are dated from August and have evolved since then. Therefore, Engie asks how this would impact the revenue computation, how does Elia tackle that. Elia answers that evolutions can't be foreseen and that the Minister took a decision based on the latest information available. Engie states that stability of parameters would be welcome. Elia takes the remark.





#### Public consultation on the Functioning Rules

COGEN Vlaanderen asks if a Y-2 Auction is confirmed. Elia states that a draft law exists – LDD v3 – where the integration of Y-2 Auction is foreseen. Therefore, Elia considers that the government will proceed with a Y-2 Auction.

FEBEG asks if a notification to the EC will also take place. Elia confirms – in fact, the design of the CRM would significantly change, therefore <u>Elia expects that</u> a notification towards the EC will take place, <u>but it is up to Belgian government to initiate the process</u>.

Regarding indirect cross-border participation to the CRM, Zandvliet Power asks if law changes will also happen in neighboring countries in support of cross-border participation and if Elia has a view on this. There is an ongoing ACER decision that covers the topic, namely on the participation of CMUs in multiple CRMs. However, it is to be noted that it would be the responsibility of each Member State to handle their own legislation.

## Update to the regulatory framework

Febeliec asks if the price in the Y-2 Auction will be cheaper than the volume contracted in the Y-1 Auction. Elia can't yet give a proper answer to the question as there are potential upwards and downwards effects on the cost of the CRM. It is then discussed that evaluating the impact of the volume that will not participate to the Y-1 Auction as they would participate to the Y-2 Auction is important.

Regarding the evolutions to the regulatory framework, Luminus expresses its disappointment on the absence of a formal consultation as the Cabinet had suggested in earlier WG Adequacy meetings.
