Recommendation of the Elia Users Group on the adapted proposal of the FGC

Next Steps

State of play:

- During the WG Belgian Grid of 17 October 2018 it was decided to draft a recommendation highlighting the 5 most important articles commonly supported articles by all the market parties which have been amended by the FPS Economy.
- The 7 topics highlighted in the recommendation are:
 - Consistency and clarification of certain definitions
 - New versus existing unites
 - Timing of the Advice of FPS (during the public consultation) and deadline for the regulator to take a decision on deliverables submitted by Elia
 - Control area
 - Technical requirements
 - Substantial modernization
 - Closed Distribution Systems

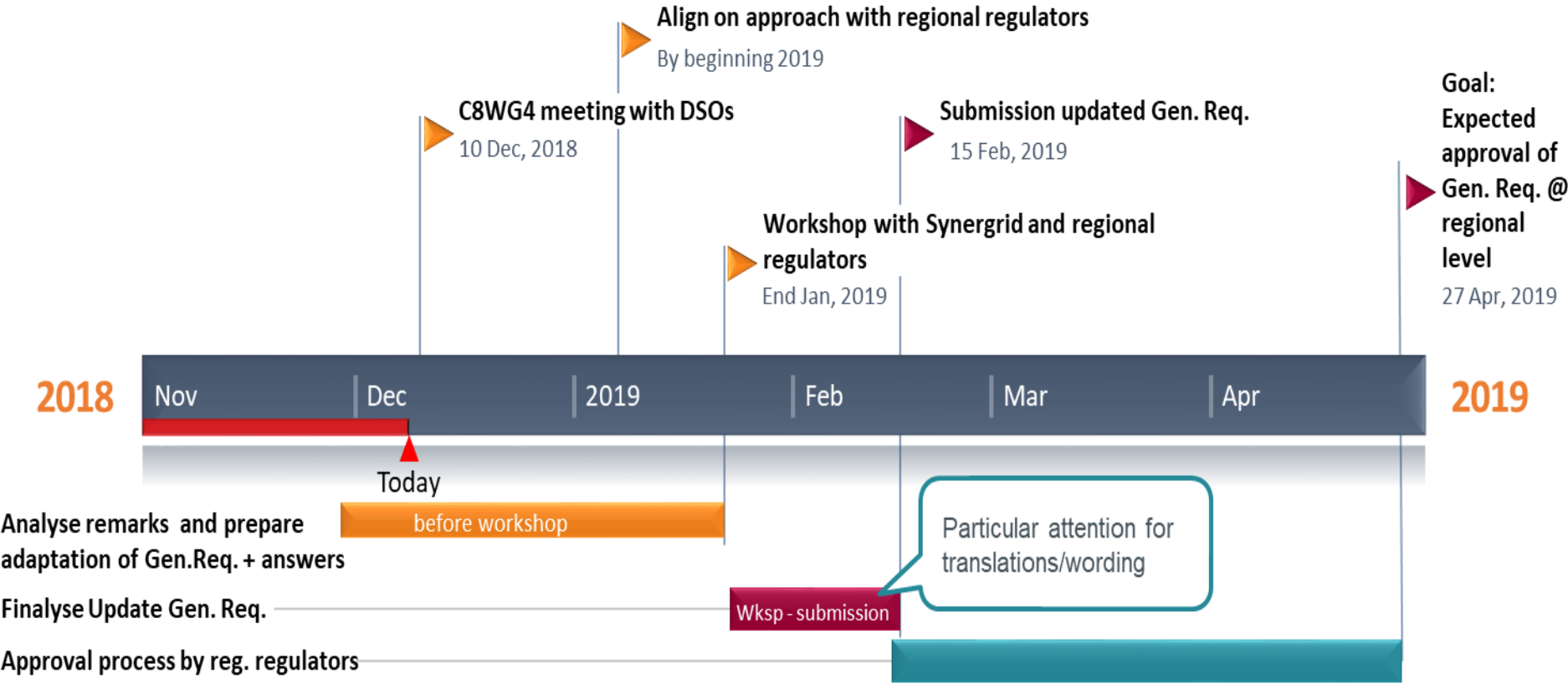
Important remark: The general proposal for the above-mentioned topics included in the recommendation was to return to the original text proposal as submitted by Elia in May 2018.

- WG Belgian Grid drafted and approved the recommendation on 26 November 2018
- The recommendation was sent to the members of the plenary meeting for comments → No comments and/or remarks were received.

Conclusion:

- The Plenary meeting of the Elia Users Group approved the Recommendation on 6.12.2018
- The recommendation has been sent to the FPS Economy, the Minister and the regulatory authorities (CREG, VREG, CWaPE and BRUGEL)

General Requirements – Next steps



FGC: Drop-off procedure

Elia has been informed by FPS Economy that a provision will be included in the FTR – this as recommended in the CREG advice:

Text proposal:

*“Uiterlijk 12 maanden na de inwerkingtreding van dit besluit legt de transmissienetbeheerder een wijziging van het **modelcontract voor de toegang** tot het net ter goedkeuring aan de commissie voor teneinde daarin een **procedure voor eenzijdige beëindiging** door de toegangshouder en/of de balanceringsverantwoordelijke van hun respectievelijke aanduiding als toegangshouder en balanceringsverantwoordelijke vast te leggen in **geval van wanbetaling**, die ultiem kan uitmonden in het verplicht afschakelen door de transmissienetbeheerder van het (de) betrokken toegangspunt(en).”*

Deze procedure komt tot stand na raadpleging door de transmissienetbeheerder van de betrokken marktpartijen.”
