# Elia named 'Top Employer' for the second consecutive year

Brussels - For the second year in succession, Elia can count itself among the best employers in the country. The Top Employer label is awarded in more than 115 countries to companies that make providing an excellent working environment a top priority. This year there are 64 companies that can count themselves among this group in Belgium. Over the past year, Elia has invested heavily in internationalisation and training. The label is a nice accolade and an additional advantage when it comes to attracting new talent that is in short supply on the labour market.

In 2018, Elia made a strong commitment to provide more internal training. Accordingly, 60% more training courses have been organised, stepping up language and safety training in particular. In addition, an ambitious internal programme has been worked out to bring about a real culture change, with more attention being paid to feedback and co-creation, among other things. The company's increasing internationalisation is undoubtedly contributing to this, for Elia's acquisition of an additional stake in our German subsidiary 50Hertz means the company is steadily developing into an international group. This is offering Elia's employees extensive international career opportunities. Elia clearly has major pulling power when it comes to attracting fresh talent, because over the past two years, the company has recruited more than 265 new employees at a time when applicants are in very short supply.

Elia's investment in a strong HR policy already became apparent in 2018 when Peter Michiels was named HR Manager of the Year.

This will also be reflected in a strong HR policy with more vacancies for digital profiles and more training courses on digital skills and technology. To celebrate the Top Employer label, today all Elia employees were pampered by being given something extra in addition to the usual daily piece of fruit.




