# Pieter De Crem succeeds Kris Peeters on Elia's Board of Directors

Brussels, 26 February 2021 | Pieter De Crem was co-opted as a non-independent director on to Elia's Board of Directors at the recommendation of Publi-T (core shareholder). He replaces Kris Peeters, who has been appointed Vice-President of the European Investment Bank. Mr De Crem's directorship takes immediate effect and board members will be asked to confirm his appointment during the Ordinary General Meeting on 18 May 2021. As a nonindependent director, he will be remunerated in the same way as the other board members.

# **Pieter De Crem**

Pieter De Crem was born on 22 July 1962 in Aalter, Belgium. He holds degrees in Romance philology (KUL), European and international law (VUB) and Advanced Management at Harvard Business School. He began his political career in 1989 as an attaché to the staff of Prime Minister Wilfried Martens. In 1994, he was elected Mayor of Aalter, a position he still holds today. He was elected to the Belgian Federal Parliament for the first time in 1995, and then served as President of the CD&V Group in the House of Representatives (2003 to 2007) and as chairman of the Home Affairs Committee in 2007. Mr De Crem has served as Minister of Defence (2007-2014), Foreign Trade (2014-2020), and Home Affairs and Security (2018-2020). He has also served as Deputy Prime Minister (2013-2014) and as the federal government's special envoy for the MYRRHA research project based in the Belgian Nuclear Research Centre (2017-2018).
