# Elia is named "Top Employer" for the seventh time in a row and makes significant progress in wellbeing at work and Diversity, Equity and Inclusion

BRUSSELS | Elia has been named as one of Belgium's 'best employers' for the seventh year in a row. The Belgian transmission system operator's score improved even further compared with last year, since its overall score increased from 88% to 90%. The Top Employer label is awarded to companies which are committed to providing an excellent working environment for their employees. While the effects of ActNow, our sustainability program, are once again being felt very strongly, the jury highlighted Elia's qualities in terms of wellbeing at work and Diversity, Equity and Inclusion. All the aspects that make our company attractive also received very high scores. This year, 87 Belgian companies were awarded with the label. This award is a great recognition of the work put in by Elia and all of our employees.

"We are immensely proud of the progress we have made, thanks, in particular, to our integrated campaign on microaggressions, our Women's Network and multiple interactive sessions with external experts on Diversity, Equity and Inclusion. In this way, we aim to create not only awareness but also a safe and inclusive workplace for all. We are also aware of the big steps we still have to take and we will start working on them in 2024."

### Elia obtains an overall score of 90%

The Top Employer judges awarded Elia an overall score of 90%. The strongest area of improvement was in the working environment, with the considerable increase of 23.7%. The three other most significant areas of increase were Leadership (9.03%), Rewards and Recognition (10.62%) and Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (11.74%). In addition to these strong gains, the jury also awarded our company a number of top scores (100%), for example, in corporate, organisational & change strategy, employer branding, and talent acquisition. Sustainability also scored very highly (97.36%). The two strongest increases were due to the hard work of the Diversity & Inclusion and Wellbeing teams.



### Strong appeal to meet the many challenges of our sector

The society we live in is changing. Electrification is on the move and as an electricity transmission system operator, we are at the heart of these changes. We are playing a major role in the energy transition, and that is attracting talent. This will enable us to realise our ambitions for growth, which is also why we are very active on the job market. We will need a lot of new recruits in the future to carry out our tasks successfully. Elia plans to recruit 500 people over the next four years. The jury awarded very high scores to the aspects relating to the overall attractiveness of our company (overall score of 98.7%). That is an increase of 14%, which bodes very well for the future.

Elia Group is a key player in electricity transmission. We ensure that production and consumption are balanced around the clock. We supply 30 million end users with electricity and manage 19,192km of high-voltage connections via our subsidiaries in Belgium (Elia) and northeast Germany (50Hertz), meaning that we are one of Europe's top five transmission system operators. With a reliability level of 99.99%, we provide society with a robust power grid, which is important for socioeconomic prosperity.
